Important News from the Theatre Manager

Dear Customers

Some of you are aware that Wyllyotts experienced ticketing problems in January. Our ticketing servers failed and then we discovered our IT company had not properly backed up any of our box office data since November. This left us with no access to accurate seating plans or sales figures for any shows. For certain shows we do not know where customers are sitting so we can only sell 'unallocated seats'. This means that for the shows affected you will be allocated a seat on the night. However, we have undersold these shows so you can be sure that you will sit with your friends and you will have some choice of seats. This system of seating people is our only practical option in these circumstances.

Please bear with us at this very difficult time for staff and customers. The loss has been devastating and is not the fault of any of the staff here so please help us and support us through this. As a non-profit making charity we are obviously trying to recoup the financial losses. Please be assured that no bank or personal details will have been shared, it is the opposite – we cannot access any of the existing data.

On a positive note this is a short term problem and we will be back to normal soon.

Wyllyotts is also actively seeking investment in this much loved building and we hope to make some exciting announcements very soon.







During the evening Steve and Micky Hazard will talk candidly about their playing days at White Hart Lane and their opinions on the game in general, not to mention the current Tottenham team.


